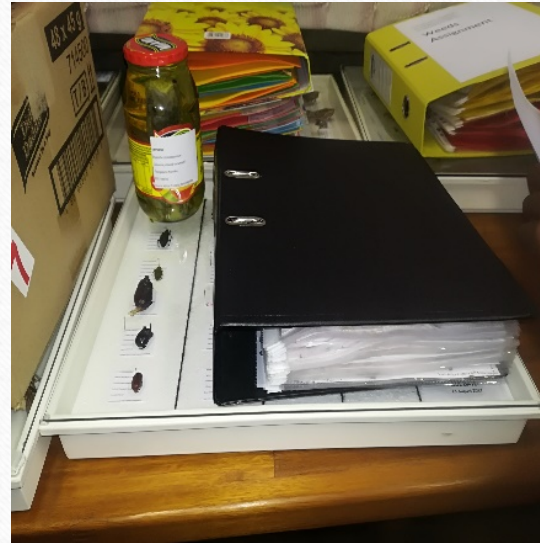

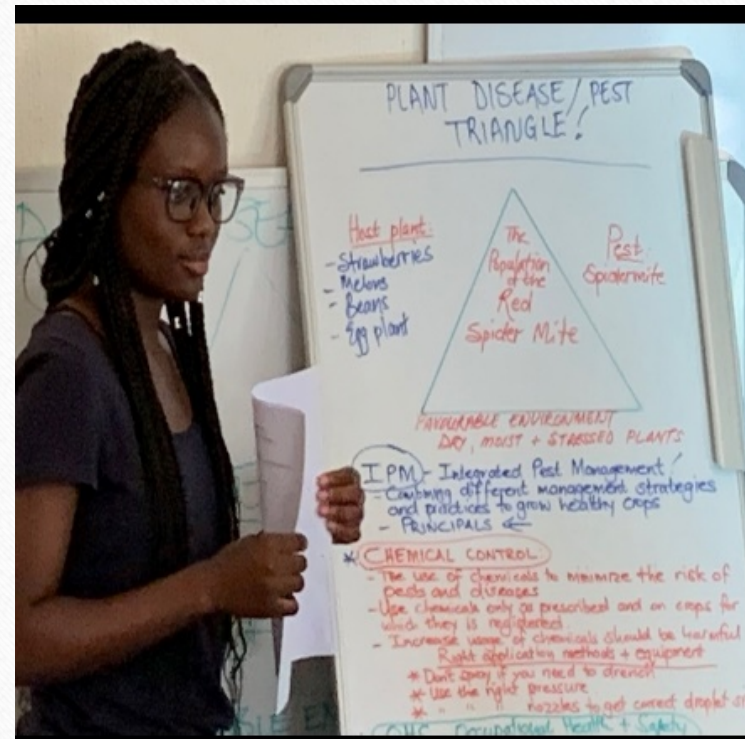

Benefits of the Australian trip

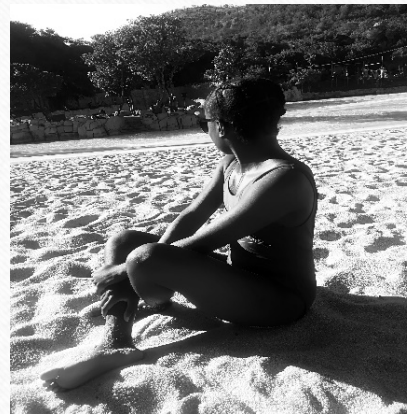
- At the moment South Africa is losing top soil at a rapid pace, I want to know what we can plant that will reduce the loss of top soil and that will not affect our indigenous plants.
