
FIELD OF INTEREST:








WHY IS HUMAN HEALTH IMPORTANT?

- Over the 2 years SA Stats indicates a 98.2% of deaths were due to illnesses/diseases _____ medicinal plants _____ deaths.


% distribution of deaths by main groups of causes of death 2014-2015

THE DIFFERENT USES OF MEDICINAL PLANTS:


- Bathing/soaking in

- Steaming








5 COMMONLY USED MEDICINAL PLANTS IN DURBAN-KZN:

Acacia Xanthophloea


WHAT I HOPE TO GAIN BY GOING TO Oz:
