It all began with viticulture, I was so interested in wines that I even considered making it my career, it was in 2008 when I knew about viticulture





#### Why should I be selected

- In 2013–14 Australian horticulture (excluding wine grapes) had a gross value of \$8.73 billion (R134,43billion), ranked third behind the meat and grain industries. The major product groups had the following gross value of production in 2013–14:
- Fruit and nuts: \$3 187 million
- Vegetables: \$3 510 million
- Nursery, cut flowers and cultivated turf: \$1 247 million
- According to the Department of Agriculture, Forestry and Fisheries (DAFF), the gross value of agricultural production was an estimated R247bn in 2016, with horticulture contributing 28.5% to this total. Horticultural production was 11.9 million tons, with a gross value of R70.4bn for the marketing season ended June 2016.
