

## **IPPS SOUTHERN AFRICA – YOUNG HORTICULTURIST EXCHANGE PROGRAM 2025**

**SUBMIT NOMINATION BEFORE 10<sup>TH</sup> FEBRUARY 2025**

IPPS Australia and IPPS Southern Africa have an established exchange program. As of January 2025 IPPS SA and IPPS New Zealand have entered into a similar exchange program agreement! The intention is to offer young horticulturists at the start of their career, an opportunity to gain experience of a different plant production industry, and to build a better understanding of the host country.

The chosen candidates will visit their allocated host country, Australia/New Zealand, for a period of about two weeks during April and May 2025, where they will be hosted by the local nursery industry. They will attend the host Regions annual conference and may be required to work in nurseries, as well as visiting gardens and other places of horticultural interest.

The Southern Africa Board will **select and sponsor four top candidates** from the nominations received to attend the **IPPS SA Conference** to be held in Worcester, from 25–28 March 2025. The selected candidates will participate in the next round of selecting the final two candidates.

### **GENERAL IMPORTANT CRITERIA FOR NOMINATED CANDIDATES:**

1. Successful nominees, chosen for the final selection at the 2025 SA Annual Conference will be announced **by 17 February 2025.**
2. The candidates must be between the ages of 19 and 30.
3. **The candidates are required to become IPPS members for at least 2 years from the date of nomination.**
4. Each of the **four selected candidates** will be required to introduce themselves and their background in plant production/horticulture, through a short presentation at the SA Regional Conference. This talk should include a short background on the candidate's horticultural field of interest and what they personally hope to gain from the international exposure. The selected candidates will also assist the conference organizer, during conference, with various tasks.
5. **Conference, travel and accommodation costs will be paid by IPPS Southern Africa.**
6. At the Regional AGM, IPPS members will vote to choose one candidate to go to Australia and one candidate to go to New-Zealand.
7. The chosen candidates will be required to present the same talk at the Australian/NZ Region conference.
8. IPPS Southern Africa pays the airfare to Australia/New-Zealand and the Australian/New-Zealand Region pays travel, accommodation and conference costs for the duration of the stay. The candidates will have to provide for own pocket money and any other incidentals.
9. The chosen candidates will have to give a report back presentation on his/her exchange experience at the next Southern Africa conference in 2026. **Conference, travel and accommodation costs will be paid by IPPS Southern Africa.**
